BLOCK HOUSE MUD COLLECTION CRITERIA

(as per current contract 3-05)

Section III – A

If solid waste exceeds the volume of the Cart, up to four (4) additional Bags, Bundles or Containers of solid waste placed next to the Cart will be picked up by the Contractor on the normal collection day.

EXHIBIT A (Definitions)

- 1. **Bags** - plastic sacks designed to store refuse with sufficient wall strength to maintain physical integrity when lifted by the top. Total weight of a bag and its contents shall not exceed 35 pounds.*
- 3. **Bundle** - tree, shrub and brush trimmings securely tied together and forming an easily handled package not exceeding 4 feet in length or 40 pounds in weight.*
- 4. **Cart** – A waste receptacle provided by the Contractor, with a capacity not less than 90 gallons nor more than 96 gallons.*
- 6. **Container** - a receptacle with a capacity of greater than 20 gallons but less than 35 gallons, constructed of plastic, metal or fiberglass, having handles of adequate strength for lifting and having a tight fitting lid capable of preventing entrance into the container by vectors. The top of the container will have a diameter greater than or equal to that of the base. The total weight of a container and its contents will not exceed 60 pounds.*
